- 1. ONLINE: To register, please log on to www.fdsa.org and see 'Latest News' on the main page for a link to '2013 Online Registration'. To use this method, you must have a debit or credit card and an email address. Online registration will be available starting Monday, March 11th. Please ensure you receive a 7-digit reference number upon completion of registration or the process was NOT completed.
- 2. **OFF-SITE:** FDSA will offer two evenings of registration at Willie O'Ree Arena (cash or cheque ONLY):
 - a. Friday, March 15th, 6:00 pm 8:00 pm, Main Lobby
 - b. Friday, April 12th, 6:00 pm 8:00 pm, Main Lobby
- **3. OFFICE REGISTRATION:** For 2013, FDSA will only be offering three day-time registrations at the FDSA office (cash, cheque, debit or credit):
 - a. Sat. March 16th, 10:00 am 1:00 pm
 - b. Sat. April 13th, 10:00 am 1:00 pm
 - c. Sat. April 27th, 10:00 am 1:00 pm (LAST DAY for 2013 registration).

4. DIVISION I & PREMIERSHIP:

- a. All Premiership players must be registered NO LATER than Saturday, March 16th @ 1:00 pm.
- b. All Division I players must be registered NO LATER than Saturday, April 13th @ 1:00 pm.

- c. No on-site registration will be held during Premiership or Division I tryouts.
- d. Individuals MUST be registered prior to participating in tryouts.
- e. Outdoor turf scheduling for Premiership & Division I tryouts is weather dependent and subject to cancellation.

5. PLEASE NOTE:

- Register Early. Registrations submitted AFTER the deadlines outlined will be subject to a \$25 late fee and may need to be placed on a first-come, first-serve wait list.
- b. FINAL Registration Deadline for Micro, Mini, Youth programs: 1:00 pm on Saturday, April 27th.
- c. FDSA cannot accept faxed registrations. If you plan to register online, you must personally register yourself; office staff cannot do this for you.
- d. Premiership Players: Tryouts will run March 25th April 13th.
- e. Division I Players: Tryouts will run April 22nd May 11th.
- f. Family Rate: Families with 3 or more children in the FDSA summer program will receive a \$15 discount for each child (must register all 3 or more children at the same time to receive this discount).
- g. Each child (except Premiership and Division I players) will receive a soccer jersey they can keep at end of season.
- h. NSF Fee: A fee of \$25 will be charged.



Welcome to the 2013 Micro Soccer Season!

Players born in 2009 or 2010 (4U) / Players born in 2007 or 2008 (6U)





ith summer fast approaching, FDSA welcomes all new and second-year Micro soccer players and parents to another great season of fun and excitement.

The season is set to begin with teams taking the fields for their first outing on Monday, May 27th (4U) and Tuesday, May 28th (6U). As in past years, games cancelled due to inclement weather will be rescheduled to Wednesday (4U) and Thursday (6U) of the same week, same time and same location.

With over 40 teams and 500+ players expected for this season, we need volunteers to coach and assist teams. Lack of experience or lack of soccer knowledge should not to be seen as a major obstacle as our simplified rules and small team sizes make it easy to learn the basics of coaching soccer. At this age group, parental involvement is strongly encouraged to help coaches and volunteers.

As a coach, you will need to commit some extra time to learning your role. You will be required to attend the coaches information session on Tuesday evening, May 14th and a morning onfield Practical Training Session on Saturday, May 25th. At these sessions you will receive demonstrations and information on an 11-week Micro Soccer Session Plan with age specific drills for the entire season.

Don't have the time to commit to the entire season? Keep in mind that assistant coaches will also be required in order to accommodate coach vacations or unavailability. If interested in volunteering, please contact the FDSA office at 451-1342 or email for more information. See you on the fields!

or those new to the Mini program, 2013 will be your first opportunity to play on properly lined fields with fixed nets. For those returning, it will be a chance to hone your skills and further develop your knowledge of the game. As in years past, the Mini teams will be gender specific and divided into two age categories (8U & 10U). The 10U teams will retain 7 players on the field for the 2013 season - 6 players and 1 goalkeeper.

NEW! This season the 8U category will be playing a 5 v 5 system (4 players and 1 goalkeeper). Also, based on member feedback, 8U will be scheduled for 75 minutes on the turf (10U will remain the same with 90 minute time slots).

Both the 8U and 10U will continue playing twice a week at various locations throughout the city, including the artificial turf fields.

he 2013 youth soccer season is gearing up to be another exciting summer on the pitch! Youth soccer continues to be one of the fastest growing sports in Canada and the FDSA is proud to be able to provide quality soccer programs to youth players in the greater Fredericton Area.

Major highlights for the 2013 season:

- ★ In an effort to balance the number of registrants across all youth groups, the age classifications will remain as 12U, 15U and 18U.
- ★ **NEW!** The Youth Kick-Off Tournament will only be held for the 12U age category, on the second weekend of June.
- ★ The Year-End Jamboree will remain status quo for this season.
- ★ The selection of teams will be similar to last season. Teams will be selected by FDSA staff using the player ratings collected at the end of 2012. Players will be assigned to teams based on their skill level and every effort will be made to ensure each team receives an equal amount of players at various skill levels, ensuring a balanced league.

NOTE: For players who do not have a current rating, they will be randomly assigned to teams. There will NOT be any modified games or evaluation prior to the start of the season.

12U Boys and Girls (players born in 2001 or 2002)

FDSA will retain the 7v7 gender specific format for the 12U league.

15U Boys and Girls (players born in 1998, 1999 or 2000)

The 15U league will be gender specific for the 2013 season. We are anticipating a good number of teams for this division as teams from other clubs will again be invited to join the FDSA.

18U Boys and Girls (players born in 1995, 1996 or 1997)

Teams will be gender specific for the 2013 season. Teams from other clubs will again be invited to join the FDSA.

SPECIAL EVENTS:

YOUTH KICK-OFF JAMBOREE

Following a week of play, the 12U youth season will kick off with a jamboree on Friday and Saturday, June 7th & 8th. The rain date is Sunday, June 9th. Individual and team photos will be taken at this time.

YEAR-END YOUTH TOURNAMENT

The summer season will end with a fun tournament on Saturday, August 10th.

Coaches Honorarium (Policy 016)

In a continued effort to attract, train and retain qualified coaches, FDSA offers a \$25 honorarium to recreational coaches and assistant coaches.

The honorarium policy applies to:

- Any individual who registers as an official volunteer with FDSA and fulfills the role of a coach or assistant coach for any of FDSA's Division II Micro, Mini or Youth teams. If the volunteer is a parent, has more than one child that they coach and the children are on different teams (i.e. coaches more than one team), application can be made for an honorarium for each team coached.
- Each team may only have one coach and one assistant coach eligible for an honorarium.
- Sideline helpers (parents who assist the Coach or Assistant Coach on the sideline) utilized in the FDSA Micro, Mini or Youth programs are not eligible for an honorarium.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Honorariums will only be given to those individuals who make official application to the FDSA office and meet the above outlined criteria.

GENERAL REFUND POLICY (Policy 014)

RECREATION REGISTRATION FEE REFUNDS:

If a child withdraws from the summer program prior to July 1st, 2013, **50% of the FDSA portion** of the registration fees paid for that child will be refunded (Micro = \$31.25; Mini (8U) = \$36.75; Mini (10U) = \$42.25; Youth = \$47.75). If a child withdraws from an FDSA program after July 1st, no refund will be provided.

COMPETITIVE REGISTRATION FEE REFUNDS:

If a child has tried out for an FDSA competitive team and that child is not selected for the team, the FDSA will refund all fees with the exception of the Competitive Try-Out Fee and any late registration fees. Those players not selected for an FDSA Premiership team are automatically eligible to attend the FDSA Division I tryouts (if applicable) or to join the FDSA recreation league. At this point of time, adjustments will be made accordingly and refunds given if applicable. No refund(s) will be processed until all competitive teams have been chosen and the recreation season has commenced. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after July 1st as per above policy.

If the FDSA decides, before the end of try-outs, that there are insufficient players to form a Competitive team, then the total fees paid will be refunded.

All other refund requests will be at the discretion of the FDSA Board of Directors.

Welcome to the 2013 Division I Soccer Season!





he soccer season is fast approaching and plans are again underway for a successful summer of Division I soccer. This is a developmental program for the Premiership teams and a program that allows athletes to play at a higher level of competition than recreation. Teams will be selected through an open tryout process, beginning the week of April 22nd. For the summer

of 2013, FDSA may field up to nine (9) Division I teams. U12 girls (2 teams)*, U12 boys (2 teams)*, U14 girls, U14 boys (2 teams)*, U16/18 girls & U16/18 boys. With the continued success of the RDP program, there should be an impressive contingent of returning and new players entering the program.

The teams will once again play in the West Region Soccer League (WRSL), allowing Division I teams to have a regular schedule of practices and games. The teams will play club teams from FDSA, New Maryland, Western Valley and Oromocto during the week or weekend and teams from the South Region (Saint John area) on some weekends, while vying for a position in the West New Brunswick Championship. Teams will also be

competing for the right to represent the region at the Soccer NB Provincial Championships in late August.

NOTE: The Division I team that finishes first in the WRSL will be eligible to participate in the Soccer NB Division I Provincial Club Championships. The second provincial spot will be determined by a play-off.

* If the player numbers and skill warrant a second team.

Stay tuned! Coaches for the Division I Program will be posted on the FDSA website once the selection process has been completed.

For games scheduled in New Maryland or Oromocto, inclement weather updates must be confirmed through their respective hotlines (see below).






