1. What is a City of Fredericton Recreation Card?

Recreation cards contain the number you will use to register for organized ice sports, field sports, outdoor pool lessons and municipal daycamps. The cards are only used at the time of registration and are not required for day to day use.

2. Who needs one?

Anyone playing in sports programs using City of Fredericton indoor ice, or sports fields or those registering for municipal day camps and outdoor swim lessons.

3. Do I need a Recreation card for drop in activities like public skating?

No, you do not need a Recreation card for drop activities like public skating, the use of the walking tracks, the use of City of Fredericton parks and playgrounds or for programs at the Fredericton Indoor Pool.

4. How much do they cost?

Recreation cards are free for residents of the City of Fredericton and communities

participating in the Recreation Service Agreements.

Those living outside these areas may still get a Recreation Card by paying the applicable outside user fees.

5. Where do I get a Recreation Card?

Cards are available at the Recreation Office at 514 Queen Street, the Fredericton Indoor Pool or City Hall Service Center.

6. What ID do I need to bring to get a Recreation Card.

You will need to provide the following identification:

- Valid Driver License

Or

- Two current pieces of the following:

Property Tax bill, NB Power Bill, or Water/Sewer Bill – mailing address, name must be consistent for both.

7. Does each person obtain their own Recreation Card?

Yes – it is one card per person.

For example – if your daughter plays hockey and your son plays baseball they would each need one.

8. Do my children need to be with me to get their Recreation Cards

No. Parents/ guardians can obtain the cards for their children.

9. Do I need a new card every year?

Yes.
